How to apply for funding:

To attend one or more of our courses in 2018-2019/20, your **school / institute** must apply for funding for you and your colleagues from the **European Union Erasmus+**

Funding Programme. The deadline for applications is Friday 2 February 2018, 12.00 Brussels time.

Application for Erasmus+ funding **must** be done **electronically**:

1. **Your school must register** on the European Commission Authentication Service (ECAS)
2. Your school must get a Participant Identification Code (PIC)

This is a once-only process for your school and the registration will last until 2020. **This can be done NOW, so don't delay!**
